Guidelines to Help Each One Enjoy The Wilderness

It is necessary that you read these Guidelines to your entire family or group each time before you come. If you are unable to comply with these or desire some variance, please ask us to consider your request **prior to your arrival**.

All persons, families or groups, must provide their own health and accident insurance when on The Wilderness Fellowship Ministries property or at an event sponsored by TWFM.

FOR YOUR SAFETY, AND THE SAFETY AND RESPECT OF OTHERS, WE DO HAVE A FEW ABSOLUTES.

- NO alcoholic beverages or other drugs
- NO fireworks of any kind are allowed
- NO guns of any kind-sport or other – **only exception is squirt guns**
- NO SMOKING in or near the buildings or on the trails. NO pets allowed in the buildings or on the ground.
- NO TV's, radios, personal electronic devices, except for ministry leader use.
- NO candles.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE DATE AND TIMES & ORIENTATION

1. It is very important for us to know your arrival time, especially if you are arriving **after** our regular office hours, which are 8:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. We have set aside a time to greet you and see you settled into your cabin **at the time you say you will be arriving**.
2. **If you are going to be later than your scheduled arrival time, please let us know what time you will arrive.**
3. Please plan to keep your departure time, as other groups are scheduled accordingly.
4. **Please take note of the cancellation policy posted on the website regarding the facility you reserved.**
5. Orientation is for everyone. Questions and comments are welcome during this time.

VEHICLES

1. Always drive slowly on the grounds, carefully, watch for children.
2. Please park in designated parking areas only.
3. Please leave your vehicle parked once you arrive at your site and avoid unnecessary driving.
4. Do not park in front of buildings, and please be gentle on the grass.
5. Please stay on the main roads to your destination.

CARE & USE OF FACILITIES

1. Please camp only in the area that you have reserved.
2. The showers / bathrooms in the FFRC are intended for use by FFRC retreatants only.
3. You will be held responsible for paying the cost of repair or replacement of any Wilderness property damaged, lost or broken by your group.

ACTIVITIES

1. In the summer the beach is open, however, TWFM does not provide a lifeguard. Children must be accompanied by an adult
2. **Modest Swim apparel is required. No bikinis or bare tummy swimsuits.**
3. When using the boats, canoes, paddleboats or other water equipment, life jackets must be worn at all times.
4. When fishing, all Wisconsin fishing laws apply.
5. Hayrides, sleigh rides, swimming, boating, canoeing, water skiing, snow skiing, skating, and all other activities are all done **AT YOUR OWN RISK. TWFM does not provide insurance for you. You and your group must assume this responsibility.**
Please schedule sleigh & hayrides when you make your reservation.
