Amazing perspective and a desire to move forward and impact the Kingdom of Heaven from where he now sits—a wheelchair. Mark is a fighter and one of the hardest workers I know, so from the hospital room he has already touched others through his CaringBridge site, www.caringbridge.org/visit/markswenson2. Please pray that all these "getting close to the finish line things" will go quickly and without hic-

cups! We'll let you know when it is open. But is should be pretty soon. Yeah!!



I ended chapter 11 asking, "Have you heard about TABS?" Here's the story. Shortly after arriving at Glendale Lutheran Church in Seattle, WA, I was asked by the church parish worker, Amy Dye, to take over the leadership of the High School Youth Bible Studies. I agreed to attend the Bible Study held at her home. There were 3 girls, Amy, and myself. A small beginning and with no idea of what lay ahead. I agreed to give leadership to the Bible Study. As the Holy Spirit began stirring in the lives of the teenagers, many of them wanted to bring their school friends. They decided it

was necessary to give their teenage Bible study a name. The vote was an acronym, TABS—Teen Age Bible Study. Chris Morgan, an artist, designed a red and white TABS button that the kids wore to school. This brought on the question, "What's TABS?" The answer was, "Come with me on Tuesday nights and find out." Do I dare to tell you that TABS attendance grew to a 1-hour prayer time, ½-hour sing and share time, followed by 1 ¼-hour Bible study, and from 5 high schoolers to a maximum attendance of 185, with an average of 120 youth.

Out of the TABS youth group came The Commitment, 60 high school teens committed to Christ and to sharing this commitment with other youth. They traveled through Washington State sharing the good news




through Gospel music, readings, skits, and personal testimonies of their walk with Jesus. TABS youth also enjoyed work camp in British Columbia, canoe trips, Cascade Wilderness hikes to Holden Village, plus many other special events which were focused on helping the youth to grow in their relationship and commitment to live all out for Jesus, coupled with a sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's leading and the unchangeable authority of the Bible, God's Holy Word.

Why do I share this with you? Because it led to what The Wilderness is today, with its goals and motivation, its seeking to lead individuals, families, youth groups, church families, into a Holy Spirit led, abundant life in our troubled hurting world.
