Along with the cabin, however, the outhouse and new shower house must also be functional per state regulations. The need continues to grow and we will continue to build



as the Lord provides finances, labor and His blessing as He grows this ministry. Please be praying about whether God would like you to fund (or be part of funding) another prayer cabin — we still have nine sites available!

Friend and frequent guest Ken Flannery has graciously done all the rough-in wiring and finish electrical work on the last four prayer cabins. What a huge gift to the Prayer Cabin ministry. Recently, he informed us that after the Grace he is unable to continue. We are so thankful for his excellent service. However, we have a huge need for an electrician who might be willing to pick up the mantle of this special service for the Shalom Cabin and others going forward. ### **Shalom Cabin Progress**

Holes were dug and foundation posts put in in September. Britt Gonyea and his crew came and framed in the cabin in one day, walls were constructed and raised, roof trusses were put in place and sheeting was



on the porch at the end of the day! Praise the Lord! Since then, the sheeting is on the entire roof along with tar paper. Shingles will go on Nov 4-5 by volunteers Dan and Tom
