Next on the list is finishing the inside of the Shalom Cabin, which is our ELEVENTH prayer cabin. Praise God for the provision, for a warm fall to complete all of these projects enough to have them buttoned up for winter, and for the many volunteers who have been here to help get it all done!



Future Prayer Cabins

We would love to have more prayer cabins funded! We are just waiting on the Lord for His timing and pro-

vision. Please be in prayer with us about that, and that God would raise up supporters who are willing to invest in the ministry here by way of funding a prayer cabin. Or maybe several who would like to donate toward a cabin! We have nine more cabin sites marked out in our Prayer Cabin Village, and we would love to see that come to fruition. With each new cabin that has opened recently, we see them filled just as quickly. The need is there! Is God moving on your heart to be involved in funding a cabin, either in part or in full? We would love to talk to you!

Conditional Use Permit

Along with the prayer cabins that have been completed, we are quickly bearing down on the deadline for our conditional use permit which expires on September 24th of this year. The conditional use permit, when granted by the county, allows us to use land for something other than that for which it is zoned (i.e. building a prayer cabin on land that is zoned agricultural). The permit is granted for three years, at the end of which time we must re-apply. Please pray for God's favor for renewal.

New Merch

As you enter our office these days, your eyes will automatically travel to our display of merchandise that we now have on hand. This includes tshirts, sweatshirts, hats, mugs, stickers and clings with The Wilderness logo on
